LASH IN BLOOM F.A.Q

What is Lash in Bloom?

Using the finest imported lashes and a new technique of lash extension work together to give you fuller, longer, more durable lashes! We customize the length of lashes before the application of each tab – dramatic or natural – it's your call!

How are the lash extensions applied?

The lash extensions are tabbed closely to your lash line. Utmost care is taken to make sure that there is minimum contact with your skin.

How long does each application take?

Each treatment takes between 45 - 90 minutes to complete, depending on the effect desired. This procedure consists of the application of a full set of lash extensions.

How long will my lash extensions last?

With proper care, our treatment will last for 2 to 4 weeks. We recommend coming in for a touch-up every 2 weeks after the initial full-set application. This is to replace any lashes that may have fallen out. The longevity of your lash extensions also depend on two factors - how well you adhere to the After Care instructions, and also your natural lash growth cycle.

What is the different between our Lash in Bloom and traditional lash extensions at other salons?

- The main differences lie in our new adhesive formula, lash type and application technique. Traditional lash extensions are usually bonded with an adhesive that can harm your eyes. These extensions will also cause fuming that will in turn irritate your eyes, especially when they come in contact with water. Our new glue is an odourless, non-stinging adhesive that is strong yet comfortable and safe for your eyes and lashes.

Should I add mascara, or any other kinds of eye make-up to my lash extensions?

It is not necessary. Lash In Bloom naturally darkens your lashes and lash line. Never use waterproof mascara as all types of mascara removers may weaken the bond. If desired, you may apply eye shadow or other types of eye make-up for your preferred enhancement.

Can I shower, swim, exercise or visit a spa?

Yes, you can enjoy your lash extensions with very little adjustments made to your lifestyle. Follow your after-care tips religiously and avoid extreme heat or any extreme water activities and your lash extensions should be able to last for the stipulated duration.

Can I use eyelash curlers on my lash extensions?

We do not recommend the use of mechanical eyelash curlers on your lash extensions as the curlers might have a damaging effect on them.

What kind of lash extensions are used?

We use lashes that have an incredibly lifelike appearance. Our extensions are also extremely lightweight and crimp resistant.

How do I prevent my natural lashes from falling out?

If applied correctly, lash extensions will not cause your natural lashes to fall out prematurely. Rubbing your eyes or constantly touching and tugging your lashes could cause this. It also depends on how skilled your technician is. It is crucial to go to a skilled technician who knows what kind of weight and length your lashes can handle. Always check with your technician how long the extensions are to be applied for and request to see before and after pictures. Also, follow our After Care tips religiously to keep your lashes in good health. To strengthen and nourish your lashes, you can opt to use

our post –lash extensions care products such as the Lash Perfection serum, after removal of the lash extensions.

Can my lash extensions be removed?

Yes. However, our 'super' glue has super strength, so it's highly recommended you come back to us for a safe and thorough removal.

AFTERCARE TIPS

- Avoid getting your lashes wet within the first 24 hours. Allow the adhesive some time to dry thoroughly. A light bath or shower is advisable.
- Avoid hot steam from the shower and sauna as well as swimming pools and tanning salons for the first 48 hours.
- Avoid splashing water directly onto your face. Cleanse your face with a facial sponge or cloth instead. This is to prevent the lashes from getting entangled.
- Avoid the use of oil-based products and make-up removers on or near your lashes. Oil may dissolve or weaken the adhesive bond. Use only water-based makeup removers if necessary.
- Avoid rubbing your eyes constantly after the treatment. Gently pat and cleanse your eye area in outwards motion.
- Use lint free cotton/cotton pads to remove make-up from around your eye area. Do not use cotton balls or swabs directly on your lashes as the fibers may get entangled with your lash extensions.
